I work closely with colleagues in endocrinology, medical oncology, radiology, gastroenterology, and pathology; and I strive to deliver the state-of-the-art multidisciplinary care. Sometimes, multiple options can exist for these conditions and it is critical that patients have an in-depth understanding of their treatment options. If surgery is necessary, our team will answer questions and explain, what patients might anticipate in the pre and peri-operative period.

Clinical Productivity

Between Jan-Dec 2018, I evaluated over 2,500 patients in clinic.

During the same year, I performed around 908 surgical procedures in the operating room of which 36.3% were minimally invasive surgeries, 24.6% were breast surgical procedures and 18.1% were thyroid/parathyroid endocrine tumors. The rest of my clinical load covers general surgery cases, including but not limited to perianal diseases, biopsies, open laparotomies, insertion of implantable venous access catheters, etc.

Clinical Draw from outside local/regional area

Between Jan-Dec 2018, I evaluated over 600 non-Lebanese patients (most being from the regional area; specifically, Iraq). Of the non-Lebanese patients evaluated in clinic, I operated on 253 patients during 2018 at Clemenceau Medical Center.

Clinical Program Building / Leadership

The clinical load in the department of General Surgery at CMC has been steadily increasing, along with the complexity of cases. This increased patient volume, has allowed us the opportunity to establish several university affiliations including the Lebanese University (LU) and the Lebanese American University (LAU) within Lebanon. Part of affiliation CMC is providing rotations for their first and second year residents.

Through its affiliation with Johns Hopkins International, CMC has expanded from an almost entirely based clinical operation to a medical organization with a tripartite mission in providing, research, excellent patient care and medical education. Indeed, under my supervision, CMC has offered clinical electives for several medical residents from The Johns Hopkins University.

With the increasing number of patients, we have strengthen our capability to continue to provide clinical excellence and compassionate care to all of our patients with surgical emergencies, traumatic injuries and critical illnesses. Under my leadership, I increased the department of surgery team by adding Dr. Mahmoud Harb, after he completed fellowship training in Trauma & Critical care at the American University of Beirut.

I have also been personally interested in growing our breast surgical oncology program by establishing part-time affiliations with the best breast reconstructive surgeons in the country along with introducing new techniques like reverse mapping for sentinel lymph node procedure and lympho-venous anastomosis to help decrease the rate of lymphedema.

EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

Educational Focus

I provide daily teaching rounds with the 1st and 2nd year residents rotating at Clemenceau Medical Center from the Lebanese University (LU) and the Lebanese American University (LAU) in which I spend at least 45 minutes discussing the patients and post-operative management while going through pertinent topics in General Surgery. I also provide orientation and check-in with the Johns Hopkins residents that come for elective rotations.

As for the operating room, most of my cases are covered by a surgical resident. During each procedure, I narrate the case while demonstrating the key steps and anatomy for the assisting resident. The residents act as a first assistant and as such are allowed to perform key steps within the procedure under my direct supervision.

RESEARCH ACTIVITIES (in chronological order, earliest first by start date under each subcategory)

Research Focus

The number of patients has been steadily increasing over the past few years which demonstrate that Clemenceau Medical Center has grown into an attractive medical facility in Lebanon and in the region. As the result of higher volumes and the increased patient case mix, we have started to organize our overall research activities. More specifically regarding my own area of expertise, I have started organizing and prospectively collecting information from the medical records on CMC patients with breast and endocrine conditions.

Within the coming few years, I'm expecting to have published on multiple topics in breast surgery including our rates of re-excision in partial mastectomies, the prevalence of breast cancer in young patients in the Lebanese society and time-to-surgery for patients presenting from regional areas for treatment at our institution. As for my thyroid practice, we have been noting an increase in the prevalence of papillary carcinoma in younger patients that we will be reporting on in the near future.

One ongoing computational pathology study, involves the collaboration among the Johns Hopkins Bayview Breast cancer, Johns Hopkins School of Engineering and CMC. I am involved directly in the study, working both with the Hopkins team and my colleague, Dr. Selim Nasser, Chair of CMC pathology department. For the study we have selected 260 cases from the CMC database.

Research Program Building / Leadership

To help build our research program and facilitate our future endocrinology projects and publications, we encouraged and supported one of our young and enthusiastic faculty, Dr. Maya Barake, to complete a Master of Science in Health Research at the American University of Beirut in 2016. Dr. Barake initially joined CMC in 2013 after completing a fellowship at Massachusetts General Hospital, Harvard Medical School. Plans are in place to analyze our thyroid and parathyroid database. Dr. Barake has a very busy practice and is well versed in biostatistics and principles of performing clinical research. She is the first author on multiple original articles and poster presentation in international conferences.

In 2018, Dr. Shirin Muhsen was recruited at CMC after completing her clinical and research fellowships at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center, New York. Dr. Muhsen will be managing and organizing our prospective databases in surgical specialties. As the new director of the surgery residency program, she will be overseeing the breast and surgery research projects' progression.

I have started establishing the necessary infrastructure and scientific teams after we identified our clinical research interests and strengths now that we have the clinical load and momentum to publish our data.
